Insights/Summary of the Activity

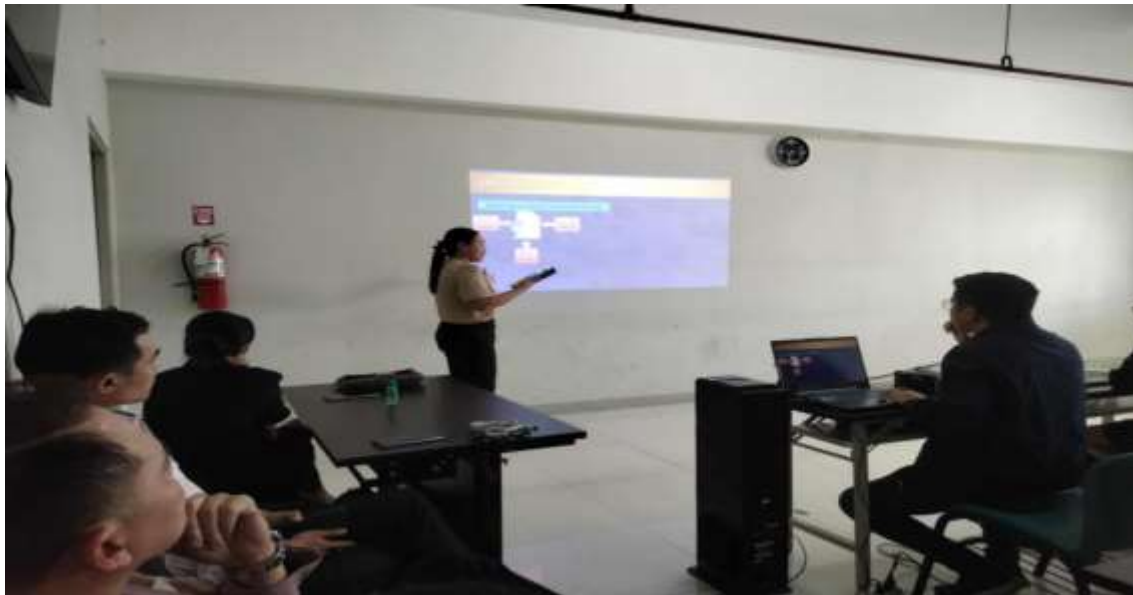
