

10.6.7 Accessible Facilities for People with Disabilities

The University of the Visayas provides accessible facilities for people with disabilities (PWDs), ensuring that all students can participate fully in academic and campus life.

Facilities include ramps, elevators, accessible restrooms, and designated seating areas in classrooms and auditoriums. These measures are supported by institutional guidelines that affirm non-discrimination and equal opportunity for PWDs.

For AY 2024–2025, 15 students with disabilities (0.26% of total enrollment) were admitted, demonstrating that accessible facilities directly support inclusion. By reducing physical and procedural barriers, PWDs are able to progress



academically alongside their peers, contributing to equitable outcomes. The visible integration of accessibility measures fosters a culture of respect, inclusivity, and empowerment, reinforcing UV's mission of transformational education.

These efforts advance SDG 4 (Quality Education) and SDG 10 (Reduced Inequalities) by ensuring disability is not a barrier to higher education.
